MEDICINE MAKING

THE CHILDREN WILL DO ALTERNATIVE WEEKS FORAGING ONE WEEK AND PLANT PRODUCT MAKING THE NEXT. BUILDING THEIR CONNECTION WITH THEIR NATURAL SURROUNDINGS WITH FUN SCIENCE EXPERIMENTS ALONG THE WAY. BUBBLE BATH, BODY OIL, CANDLE MAKING.

MUSIC

THROUGHOUT THIS COURSE THE CHILDREN WILL DO ALTERNATIVE WEEKS OF DRUMMING & SONG WRITING. ALL MATERIALS PROVIDED. MUSIC IS A WONDERFUL WAY TO BUILD SELF CONFIDENCE AND COMMUNICATION SKILLS.

TUESDAY

STORY MAPPING

THIS STEINER BASED TECHNIQUE ENCOURAGES CHILDREN TO VISUALISE NARRATIVES, PROBLEM SOLVING AND BROADENING THEIR VOCABULARY. ADDITIONALLY THERE'S A MODEL MAKING ELEMENT TO THIS MODULE WHICH ASSISTS FINE MOTOR SKILLS.

SOMATIC DANCE

SOMATIC - RELATING TO THE BODY OPPOSED TO THE MIND.

WHEN WE'RE YOUNGER IT CAN BE HARD TO UNDERSTAND WHY AND HOW THE MIND WORKS THE WAY IT DOES. THROUGHOUT THIS COURSE WE'LL FOCUS ON BUILDING THE BRIDGE BETWEEN THE TWO. LEARNING THROUGH DANCE ALLOWS A LIGHT APPROACH TO SELF CONNECTION AND REFLECTION.

WEDNESDAY

FOREST SCHOOL

THE MAIN FOCUS OF THIS SESSION IS STUDYING TREES AND OBSERVING THEM THROUGHOUT THEIR SEASONAL SHIFTS. THIS WILL BE A NATURAL CRAFT GROUP WHERE WE'LL CREATE SOMETHING FROM NATURE EACH WEEK.

THEATRE GROUP

THE MAIN FOCUS OF THIS GROUP IS DEVELOPING LANGUAGE AND LITERACY AND ENHANCING THE LOVE FOR LEARNING. THE CHILDREN WILL COLLECTIVELY WRITE A SCRIPT, ACT AND DIRECT.

THURSDAY

ECOLOGY CLUB

WE'LL BE EXPLORING LOCAL NATURE SPOTS AND STUDYING THE NATURAL WORLD AS THE SEASONS CHANGE. PAYING ATTENTION TO LIFECYCLES OF PLANTS AND ANIMALS. THE SESSION WILL INCLUDE INDOOR PLANT GROWING AND OBSERVATION

GO SLOW & SEW

SEWING IS STEADILY GROWING TO BE A LOST SKILL SET. GOING SLOW AND MAINTAINING PATIENCE IS ALSO SLIPPING IN OUR SOCIETY. THIS SESSION IS CENTRED BUILDING STRONGER RELATIONSHIPS WITH WHAT WE OWN. THE CHILDREN WILL LEARN, DARNING, WEAVING AND CREATING PLANT DYE.

Attendance Guidance

Children join initially for a two week 'Trial period', allowing time for parents/carers and practitioners to consider whether the setting is a good fit for the child.

Post the two week trial period we'll enter a different agreement which will form more consistency for us (Outdoorium) as a placement and for the families we support.

Outdoorium are aware families choosing a home-ed alternative means they're wanting flexibility with attendance so we are very conscious to ensure there is a balance for both bodies.

We operate all our lesson planning, food menu and general set-up on a 1/2 term basis focused on the movement of the seasons. Because of this we request families join us for a minimum of **one term**. This allows the children to build bonds and for the practitioner's to create a project the children can complete.

Outdoorium has created two conditions in which our consideration of flexible attendance can exist.

Attendance Contract

If you wish to relocate placement and will no longer need Outdoorium's support we request you provide a 1/2 term notice. To clarify this means within the half term break you must notify Outdoorium that your child will be leaving after the following half term.

This is a legally binding contract and a breach of the terms listed will involve an early exit fee, which equates to 1/2 term of your individualised fees.

Momentary Leave

Families who need to travel for work or special circumstances may request 'Momentary Leave'.

Outdoorium must be notified of Momentary Leave with a minimum of two weeks notice. We can hold their place at a subsidised 25% fee to support the practitioners costs.

Due to holding the space and therefore not being able to fill it with another attendee we cannot eradicate the fee completely. If a method is found where we can work deeper within that flexibility our attendees will be informed.

We will hold the space for a maximum 2 weeks.
